2010 Quilt Show

"Quilting New Trails"

August 19 - 21, 2010

RULES

This Quilt Show will be judged by an NQA-certified judge.

Any individual or group is eligible.

Entry must have been completed after 01/01/2006 and not previously entered in a SMQG quilt show.

Entries must be clean, dry, and free from all odors and pet hairs.

Entry to be three layers, quilted. (Exception: novelty or clothing).

A sleeve of 4" wide minimum must be attached to top back on all quilts and large wall hangings.

Entry must have label with the exhibitor's name, quilt name, address, and telephone number on the lower back-left corner; however, labels must be covered for judging. Labels on garments may be sewn on inside.

Include a completed entry form and a photograph for each entry.

All entries must hang for the duration of the show.

Smoky Mountain Quilters Guild will receive 15% of selling price on any quilt sold from contacts made at show.

Cash awards will be distributed equally between all first place winners in each category having six or more entries.

Quilts eligible for Best of show, Best hand-quilting, Best non-computerized machine quilting, and Artistic merit awards must be the work of one person. Cash prizes will be awarded.

The show committee and judge reserve the right to re-categorize entries. All decisions of the judge are final. The Smoky Mountain Quilt Guild reserves the right to reject any entry including those deemed inappropriate for our show or that fail to follow the quilt contest rules.

Hand Delivery: Bring to the Community Facilities Building, Franklin, NC, on Sunday, August 15, 2010, between 12 noon and 6 p.m.

Mail Delivery: Mailed quilts must be received by Wednesday, August 11, 2010. Mail to above address.

QUILT RETURN

Hand Return: All items must be picked up with proper identification and receipt between 4:30 and 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, August 21, 2010. Bring your receipt.

Mail Return: Send in a returnable box, no loose packing materials. Enclose completed registration form.

Include a separate and **pre-paid** postage label with a self-addressed label for the return of your quilt. We do not accept checks for return postage. Please call Mary Ann Budahl at 828/293-5004 or email mabudahl@morrisbb.net with any questions concerning the return of your quilt.

INSURANCE

We will provide NQA "Standard Insurance Coverage":

\$500 - for quilts 70" and greater on the shortest side

\$250 - for clothing and quilts less than 70" and greater than 24" on the shortest side

\$100 - for quilts 24" or less on the shortest side

If you desire more than "Standard Coverage," please be certain to include your quilt on your homeowner's policy, or secure additional insurance through your agent.

CATEGORIES

Sizes:

Large: Perimeter must be at least 280". Maximum width 120"

Medium: Perimeter must be less than 280"

Miniature: 24" or less on each side.

Large, pieced.

- 100 Hand Quilted
- 200 Machine Quilted
- 300 Quilted for Hire

Large, appliqué

- 400 Hand Quilted
- 500 Machine Quilted
- 600 Quilted for Hire

Large, mixed techniques

- 700 Hand Quilted
- 800 Machine Quilted
- 900 Quilted for Hire

Medium, pieced

- 1000 Hand quilted
- 1100 Machine quilted
- 1200 Quilted for hire

Medium, appliqué

- 1300 Hand Quilted
- 1400 Machine Quilted
- 1500 Quilted for Hire

Medium, mixed techniques

- 1600 Hand Quilted
- 1700 Machine Quilted
- 1800 Quilted for Hire

Group Quilt (more than one person worked on the construction of the quilt)

- 1900 All techniques and sizes
- 2000 All techniques and sizes, quilted for hire

Other Techniques (includes whole cloth quilts, crazy quilts, yo-yo's or embroidery (ex. redwork))

- 2100 All techniques and sizes
- 2200 All techniques and sizes, quilted for hire

Wearable Art (pieced and/or appliqued or embellished; must include some quilting)

- 2300 All techniques
- 2400 All techniques, quilted for hire

Youth Quilts

- 2500 All techniques (12 years and younger)
- 2600 All techniques (13 years old to 18 years old)

Innovative Art Quilts (must be original design; no patterns or kits may be used, must include some quilting)

- 2700 All techniques and sizes

Miniature Quilts (All aspects of the quilt are reduced in scale. Blocks, if used, must be no greater than 4". Overall size is limited to 24" or less on each side.)

- 2800 All techniques and sizes

Exhibition Only (not judged; limited to one entry per person)

- 2900 All techniques and sizes
