

All Roads Lead Home Class From The Quilt Teacher

Class Overview (3 1/2 Class Hours)

The road home has never been more fun! Use your orphan blocks to make beautiful house blocks. The "road" is actually a very easy alternate block. You will receive patterns to make both blocks in class. We will focus on making orphan blocks of any size fit your houses, and will be learning a few new time-saving techniques along the way. Easy and fun to make. (We will make one house block and one alternate block in class - more if you're fast!).

$\frac{1}{2}$ yd. Background:

Assortment of Fat Quarters in medium and dark fabrics

Several orphan blocks $6\frac{1}{2}$ " or smaller**

Thread: 100% Cotton thread, neutral color

Rulers:

6" x 24" Ruler

Square Up Ruler

Tucker Trimmer Ruler by Studio 180 Designs (optional)

Corner Pop Ruler by Studio 180 Designs (optional)

Rotary Cutting Equipment: Mat, cutter

Other: Sewing Machine in good working order, manual, all attachments (don't forget foot pedal and power cord).

Basic sewing supplies (pins, seam ripper, etc.)



**We will be using premade 6" (finished) blocks in class. Bring an assortment of orphan blocks in any size (preferably $6\frac{1}{2}$ " or smaller, but bring any 'leftover' blocks you have - even if they're bigger! - we may be able to make them work). If you don't have any orphan blocks, bring scraps or fat quarters of conversational prints or florals.
