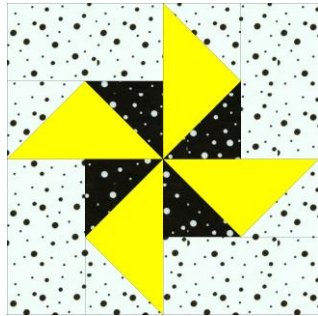





## October – Black & White Delight

**12" Finished Block.** When making the block of the month, please use 100% cotton fabric that has been washed and trimmed of selvages before cutting. All blocks should be 12½" square (raw-edge to raw-edge) when completed



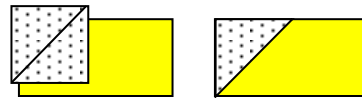
	White on Black	Cut (4) 3½" squares
	Black on White	Cut (4) 3½" squares Cut (4) 6½ x 3½" rectangles
	Yellow Bright	Cut (4) 6½ x 3½" rectangles

### Instructions:

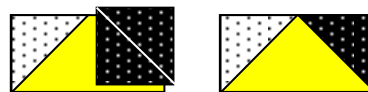
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the (8) 3½" squares.



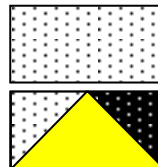
2. Flying Geese: Sew a black on white square to one end of yellow rectangle. Sew on the diagonal line you drew in step 1. Press the square towards the end, make sure the edges match the yellow rectangle, and then trim off the excess bottom two layers of fabric.



Sew a white on black square to the other end of the yellow triangle following above directions. Make 4.



3. Sew a unit 2 to a black on white rectangle. Make 4.



3. **Block assembly:** Using a scant ¼" seam, sew together no. 3 units as shown to make a 12½" block.
