

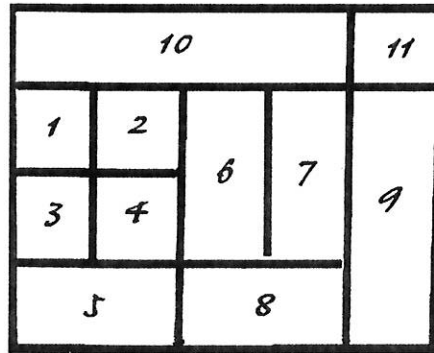
Instructions for Blueberry Jellyroll

Cutting Directions

From each length of $2' 1/2" \times 42-45"$ jellyroll strip cut these segments:

- 4 @ $2' \times 2 1/2"$ (1,2,3,4)
- 1 @ $3 1/2" \times 2 1/2"$ (5)
- 2 @ $4 1/2" \times 2 1/2"$ (6,7)
- 1 @ $4 1/2" \times 2 1/2"$ (8)
- 1 @ $6 1/2" \times 2 1/2"$ (9)
- 1 @ $7 1/2" \times 2 1/2"$ (10)
- 1 @ $2 1/2" \times 2 1/2"$ (11)

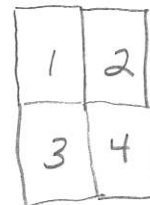
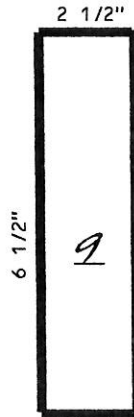
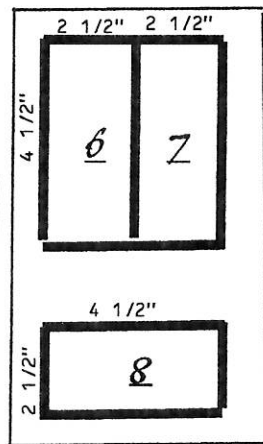
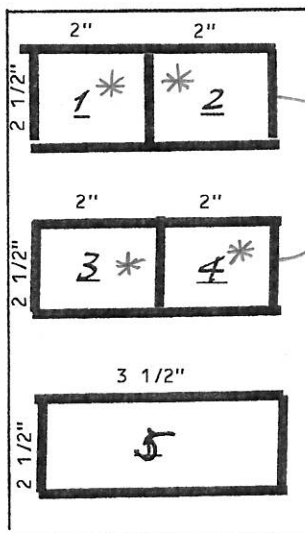
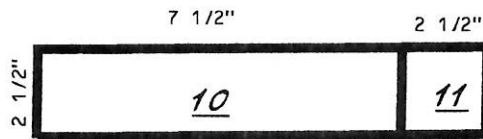
Keep segments separated by cut. Place each stack on a worktable as it will appear in the finished block. In turn, take each stack, one at a time, and put into a small bag or container. Shake the bag/container. remove pieces at random and restack into position.

Directions for Blueberry Jelly

Sew all pieces together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.

Press seams as you go.

Sew blocks together 5 blocks across by 8 blocks long.

Layer completed top to quilt as follows:

Backing (right side down)

Batting

Top (right side up)

Quilt as desired.

Trim away Excess.

Bind by cutting 2" strips across width of binding fabric - the length to go around the perimeter. (approximately 5 strips). Fold in $\frac{1}{2}$ lengthwise, wrong sides together. Match raw edges to raw edges of front of quilt.

Sew around with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam through all layers. Fold finished edge to back and hand stitch in place with whipstitch or appliqué stitch.

Materials

MAKE 40 BLOCKS - SET 5 x 8

Lap size quilt is approximately 44" x 66"

For twin size double materials and layout blocks 8 x 10

1 Jellyroll of fabric

3 yards backing fabric

3 yards batting

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard for binding.

Matching thread

FOR LAP QUILT
