



**Duo Zipper Pouch**

Supplies (fabrics are width by height—important if your fabrics are directional)

- 2- 8.5" x 8" exterior
- 2- 8.5" x 8" lining
- 2- zippers at least 9" between stops (nylon teeth, not metal)
- 2- 8.5" x 8" pieces fusible fleece (Pellon 987f)
- 2- 2" x 3" zipper tabs
- 1- 7.5" x 10" pocket

Zipper foot, marking pen, sharp scissors, quilters clips, matching thread, a few pins, a small ruler at least 6"

Optional, but not necessary: Scotch or Wonder Tape, or basting glue

You may choose to make the pouch out of all the same fabric, but it's fun to have the pocket be a surprise and maybe make the zipper tabs to match. Another option is to hand or machine embroider the front panel with the top of the design at least 2-1/2" below the top edge. Mix or match the zippers too. An oversized zipper will give you the option of a hanging tab on the side or a matching zipper pull.



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
