

On Pins and Needles:

A Pincushion, Custom Pins, and Needlecase Workshop

What you will make:

- ☀️ A choice of two pincushions - (1) Vintage Jello Mold pincushion/Vintage Milk Glass Candy Dish pincushion and/or (2) Lady's Hankie pincushion
- ☀️ A set of 9 number and 9 letter quilting straight pins - embellished and labeled
- ☀️ A unique needle book, labeled for your choice of specific needles

What you need to bring:

- ☀️ Sewing machine and tools (scissors, ruler, etc.)
- ☀️ Neutral thread as well as a color to enhance your chosen fabric(s)
- ☀️ Hand sewing needle - for sewing thread and a larger eye for embellishing
- ☀️ If you would like to try the vintage milk glass candy dish pincushion, you may have one at home or you might try looking at antique or thrift stores. They look like

- ☀️ All or some of the following:
 - ‡ A fat quarter of some fabric you really like, or several
 - ‡ An orphan block 6" up to 12", or several
 - ‡ Pieces from a cutter quilt
 - ‡ Ladies hanky, new or vintage, 12" square or smaller
 - ‡ Enough fabric to make 35" of bias binding or premade/purchased biased binding (to match your fat qtr of choice or 12" orphan block of choice)

- ☀️ Lunch and a drink
